## St. Croix County Fair Mud Bog (ATV) Rules

- 1. Brakes must be in working condition.
- 2. You must have a clevis attached to the rear of the vehicle.
- 3. Seatbelts (when applicable), helmets, and shoes must be worn by all drivers.
- 4. Track officials have the final say in any disagreements.
- 5. If an official waves a red flag, you must stop immediately.
- 6. You must stay between the track boundaries.
- 7. If you complete a full run, you must come to a complete stop at the end of the track before proceeding to the wash out area or back to the pit on the return lane.
- 8. If making a full run, you don't need to hook the pullback rope, but if you get stuck, YOU will be the one to walk back and get the rope and hook it up.
- 9. Drivers will NOT be allowed to drive if they drink any alcoholic beverages before their run.
- 10. Vehicle enhancements such as NOS, blowers, or other alterations that track officials deem unsafe for the size and/or condition of the track at the time of the event will not be allowed.
- 11. Drivers must be ready to report to the start line when they are announced.
- 12. Drivers must pay for each class they intend to run in before the beginning of that class. \*\*There will be no refunds, so make sure that your truck is running well before paying.
- 13. An ATV can be entered in the same class more than once if there is a different driver each time.
- 14. Drivers must be age 18 years old or have a signed parental consent and a valid driver's license.
- 15. If a driver is experiencing mechanical problems, he/she will be extended the courtesy of falling back no more than three places in the running order to allow time to make repairs.

Each driver who signs a release of liability form agrees that he/she voluntarily assumes the risk involved with participation in the mud bog event, and releases the St Croix County Fair, Inc. and Mud Bog from all claims for loss, damage or injury that may result.

## St. Croix County Fair Mud Bog (Trucks/Full Size Vehicle) Rules

- 1. Your vehicle must have a non-removable hard top or roll bar.
- 2. Brakes must be in working condition.
- 3. You must have a clevis attached to the rear of the vehicle.
- 4. Seatbelts, helmets, and shoes must be worn by all drivers.
- 5. Track officials have the final say in any disagreements.
- 6. If an official waves a red flag, you must stop immediately.
- 7. You must stay between the track boundaries.
- 8. If you complete a full run, you must come to a complete stop at the end of the track before proceeding to the wash out area or back to the pit on the return lane.
- 9. If making a full run, you don't need to hook the pullback rope, but if you get stuck, YOU will be the one to walk back and get the rope and hook it up.
