Health Requirements

General Rules

1. Exhibitors may show only one exhibit. Danish judging will be used.
2. All entry forms must be sent to Cindy Van Dyk 904 131st Ave, New Richmond, WI 54017 by May 31
3. Cats over 4 months of age must have a current vaccination status for Feline Rhinotracheitis, Panleukopenia, Calici Virus (FVRCP or “Distemper” vaccine, Rabies (given & certified by Veterinarian). A certificate of vaccination must be shown at time of veterinary inspection prior to show. It is recommended that cats/kittens have a booster distemper shot but is not required for showing at Fair.
4. All vaccinations must be given at least 2 weeks prior to the fair. Feline exhibitors are encouraged to have cats vaccinated for Feline Leukemia and Chlamydia. Consult your veterinarian for recommendations in your area.
5. All cats must be free of external parasites including fleas, ear mites, and ringworm. Any cat found by the show veterinarian to exhibit signs of any contagious, infectious, or communicable diseases will not be allowed to exhibit.
6. Whole male cats are not allowed. No obviously pregnant or nursing cats should be shown.
7. Cage drapes are required. Bath towels or old curtains work well held in place with clothes pins or safety pins.
