### Cut Flowers

- Rules:**
1. Please note number of blooms required and only one color when 3 blooms are requested
  2. To be staged in clear glass bottle, no bud vase, size of bottle depends on size of flower, no tinted glass.
  3. Foliage should be stripped below waterline with no additional foliage added.
