## ATCP 160.40 – Senior Citizens

1. Senior Citizens Division is limited to persons 62 years of age or over.
2. Senior Citizens exhibitor tags can be picked up at the Fair Office on Wednesday of the fair week from 11 – 7:30 pm or the Saturday prior from 10 am - 3 pm. Exhibits must be brought in on Wednesday beginning at 11am and must be in place by 8pm on Wednesday.
3. Items may be exhibited only once at the St. Croix County Fair.
