All Exhibits must be made by member.

Class A –Leathercraft

- a. Members must be enrolled in the Leather craft project
- b. Class includes stamped and tooled leathercraft projects
- c. Kits, stains, and dye may be used – original designs are encouraged

Class B – Drawing & Painting

- a. Members must be enrolled in the Drawing and Painting project
- b. Drawing projects can use pens, pencils, markers, pastels, charcoal, etc.
- c. Painting can use water color, acrylics, oils, etc.
- d. Entries should be mounted on tag board, poster board, or framed with wire hanger on back of mount. Member is encouraged to protect artwork (framing, laminating, protective sheet, tag board frame with clear plastic (NOT glass)).
- e. Exhibitor must date and sign their drawing or painting.

Class C – Stamping & Scrapbooking

- a. Members must be enrolled in rubber stamping project or arts and crafts project
- b. Scrapbooks may be homemade or from a kit and contain a cover and at least 6 pages.

Class D – Arts & Crafts

- a. Members must be enrolled in the Arts and Crafts project
- b. Exhibit may be homemade or from a kit, but if from a kit you must include the pattern or instructions.
- c. Project suggestions includes, but are not limited to: candles, basketry, sculptures, mosaic, tie dying, Papier Mache', plastic canvas, hand stenciling, origami, ornaments, latch hook, block printing, etc.

Class E – Creative Stitchery

- a. Members must be enrolled in the Creative Stitchery project
- b. Project suggestions include embroidered items, counted cross stitch, hardanger, needlepoint items, etc.

Class F – Jewelry Making

- a. Members must be enrolled in the Jewelry Making project

Class G – Graphic Art & Design

- a. Members must be enrolled in the Graphic Art and Design project

Class H – Creative Writing & Communications

- a. Members must be enrolled in the Creative Writing or the Communications project

Class I – Pottery & Ceramics

Rules:

1. All exhibits must be made by member.
2. Members must be enrolled in the pottery or ceramics project
3. Pottery pieces may be traditional kiln-fired or raku-fired.
4. Hand built pottery can be of form, pinch, coil, slab, or a combination of methods.
5. Bisque whiteware or already fired greenware ceramics do not need to be initialed.
6. Greenware kiln-fired ceramics must be kiln-fired with ceramic glazes applied.
7. Greenware kiln-fired ceramic exhibits may be of original design and crafted ceramic project or commercial. Mold un-fired clay items may be used and then painted, stained, decorated, glazed, and fired as item calls for.
8. All Greenware kiln-fired ceramic exhibits are required to have initials and date etched visibly on the bottom of the exhibit and will be dropped one ribbon placing for not meeting this requirement.

Class J – Music & Theatre Arts

Rules:

1. Open to youth enrolled in the theatre arts, puppetry, clowning, or music projects
2. Entrants must include a photo (head shot) of themselves and an index card with their name, grade, club and performance with their entry to be displayed after the performances. Photos, along with ribbons, will be returned during check-out.
3. All entries will be judged by live performance or conference judging (lots 1-4)
4. All performances must be original and can't be copies (copyright concern). Music used in performances must be original, not photocopies.
5. A piano will be provided along with a microphone and amplifier.
6. Anyone requiring the use of sound equipment must work with the sound technician. NO ONE can adjust equip.
7. Only performers can be on the stage at any time. Unsolicited involvement from other parties will result in the performer receiving one grade lower ribbon. The decision of the technician/judge will be final.
8. Approximate performance times may be provided after all entries are received. A sign in sheet may be provided.
