General Rules

1. The use of a three-dimensional display is highly recommended. A three-dimensional display may not exceed 12" in width and 24" tall. A flat poster may not exceed 14" by 22".
2. Reports and written summaries should be bound in a booklet or placed in a folder; if the report pages are not bound, they must be numbered.
3. Exhibitors are responsible for the safety and setup of their computer including any wires, cords, or heavy components. Use of a computer will not replace any existing requirements of the project. Emphasis will still be on documentation, screen print and summary.
4. Judging is based on 50% on the exhibit and 50% on the exhibitor's knowledge.

Class Designations

Class A – Computer Hardware: Computer components, computer technology, automation and manufacturing, any other physical computer equipment, how a computer works, build your own computer, etc.

Class B – Software: Computer languages, original computer program, develop a game, develop a website, develop an online game, etc.

Class C – Internet: plan a network, build your own, computer security, etc.

Class D – Robotics: program a figure 8, navigate a maze, robot multi task, play a game, build your own robot
