### General Rules

1. Open to members, Grades 4-13 enrolled in Child Development, Intergenerational, Health, and Personal Finance.
2. All displays and posters should be no larger than 14" x 22". Displays no larger than 30" x 30".
3. Exhibit Suggestions for Classes A & B: Any item from 4-H literature, toy from scrap materials, surprise bag, learning game, safety chart, milestone chart from your own life, list of activities, toys & snacks for traveling, mobile for a child's room, taste and smell experiment, poster showing duties of a babysitter, poster/booklet on first aid, etc.
4. Exhibit Suggestions for Class C: Scrapbook or poster showing work done, short biography on adopted friend, etc.
5. Exhibit Suggestions for Class D: Display or poster on a healthy diet, fitness, effects of alcohol or smoking, how to reduce stress, home safety hazards, stress management, handling sports injuries, friendship want ad, map to help increase your memory, ethnic diversity in my county, eating disorders, study tips, time management, non-violent ways to resolve conflict, teen pregnancy, cost of raising a baby, skin cancer prevention, etc.
6. Exhibit Suggestions for Class E: Write saving & spending plans, poster/display on marketing, advertising, consumer rights, costs of owning a vehicle, risks of shopping on the Internet, etc.
