REQUIREMENTS:

- * This \$250.00 scholarship is available to any high school senior planning on attending a post-secondary educational institution.
- * Applicant must reside in St. Croix County, WI.
- * The rodeo requires applicants to volunteer a minimum number of hours during their high school career. These hours must be completed at the SCV PRCA rodeo and its related activities. The rodeo takes place on Father's Day weekend in Glenwood City, WI. For those graduating in 2017 that number is 6, for those graduating in 2018 that number is 12, for those graduating in 2019 that number is 18 and for those graduating in 2020 that number is 24. These requirements will be verified by the scholarship committee.
- * List school, extracurricular activities, community service and work experience you have participated in during your high school years in resume format.
- * The application must include a letter of recommendation from your guidance counselor.
- * The award winner will be notified by a member of the SCV PRCA Rodeo Committee.
- * Payment will be made upon receipt of 1st semester transcript with a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- * If you are awarded this scholarship, you must attend a post-secondary educational institute within 12 months of your acceptance of this scholarship. Example-if awarded in 2019 you must attend by fall of 2020 to be awarded the monies after your first semester in 2021.
