How is this set up?

- *Children will need to have a parent/guardian sign the attached form in order to participate.
- *It is highly encouraged to use a younger animal. The child will need to have a parent/older youth assist the child in the show ring.
- *Animals will be checked in and are required to stay the entire weekend of the fair, unless prior arrangements have been made by the superintendent and approved by the Fair Board.
- *Animals may be provided-just ask!
- * Pre-registration is required by July 1.
- *There will be no judge, however, each child will be asked some basic questions about their animal. Examples are:

*What is the name of your animal?

*What does your animal eat?

*Do you like showing goats?

*How much does your animal weigh?

*What kind of animal is it?
